






THE AUTHORS



countries but also how to think for himself and to question things: his surroundings first, then his family and his mother's background. Thanks to him, he might just find out who she is, and who she has been...


THE AUTHORS




THE AUTHORS

After her theatre studies, **Aurelle Gaillard** started off in teaching and cultural mediation before turning to scriptwriting for comic books (*Le Royaume des licornes* with Kennes in 2020). She spends her time in her Toulouse atelier dreaming up fantasy, sci-fi, or comedy stories. She was a teacher in middle school before becoming a writer and has witnessed bullying first-hand through a student of hers, victim of cyberbullying. With the present story, she hopes to raise awareness and start a discussion on this sadly all too common phenomenon. **Camille K**. is 29 years old. After multiple and diverse professional experiences, she dives back into drawing and graduating in comic book drawing in 2018. 




THE AUTHORS


and ambitions of these children of immigrants who grew up in these suburbs.
